




Dear Resident:

In an effort to improve our local transportation system, the state Department of Transportation expects to begin work in early May on a \$3 million improvement project at the 422-662 intersection. Plans were devised in cooperation with Amity Township Board of Supervisors and Berks County Planning Commission.

The safety improvement project will include a right-turn lane for west-bound traffic on Route 422 at the Route 662 intersection, with overhead directional signs and pavement markings, and full signals on Route 422 eastbound and westbound at the intersection with River Bridge Road.

As most commuters are aware, this intersection becomes a major bottleneck for traffic during rush hour, and can cause long delays for motorists.

While PennDOT does not anticipate detours at this time, it is likely that lane alterations will be necessary during the project. I appreciate your patience as this project progresses. Once it is completed, residents will have much better driving conditions in this area.
