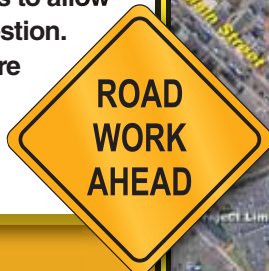

**Dear Resident:**

In an effort to improve our local transportation system, the state Department of Transportation expects to begin work in late May on a \$3.5 million improvement project to the Route 29/Main


Street Intersection in Collegeville Borough. Plans were devised in cooperation with Collegeville Borough Council and Montgomery County Planning Commission.

The improvement project will include a relocation of the current traffic signal at the foot of the Collegeville Bridge, as well as the addition of turning lanes to allow for ease of traffic congestion. Due to the historic nature of the bridge, widening the bridge is not a viable option.



As most commuters are aware, this intersection becomes a major bottleneck for traffic during rush hour, and can cause long delays for motorists.

While PennDOT does not anticipate detours at this time, it is likely that lane alterations will be necessary during the project. We appreciate your patience as this project progresses. Once it is completed, residents will have improved driving conditions in this area.
